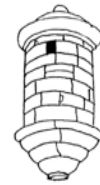


# The Citadel

## Siemens

The City of Culture 'Blade' is a major hit.

Barry Denness has agreed a visit to Siemens site. He suggests this would be best organized when all port construction is completed, and probably when the weather is improved, therefore the afternoon, Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2017 is proposed. As part of Siemens community liaison, Katy Burton with support from Alison will organize this, and owing to significant security and EHS considerations, it will have to be managed by Siemens to ensure it runs smoothly.

It is proposed to offer up to 40 places for local residents, this is manageable and proportionate to those attending the community meetings. Details to be announced.

## A63 Castle Street Scheme from Highways England

You will be aware that we are progressing the preparatory works for the A63 Castle Street scheme. As the scheme is classed as a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project, we are required to make an application for a Development Consent Order (DCO) under the Planning Act 2008. This is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate who will examine the application and make a recommendation to the Secretary of State for Transport.
