Slipway pond update

The Parks Department have now agreed that they will regularly carry out maintenance to the Slipway Ponds, between Plimsoll Way and Ha'penny Bridge Way. Diana, Adam and Linda met with them earlier in the summer to raise various concerns about the state of the pond.

Maintenance work is due to begin in September. If you have any views on the pond please get in touch.

Comment - If this was agreed in early summer why has it not happened? The level of maintenance proposed is only what it should have been having throughout.

The alternative was to clear both ponds completely and keep them clean.
